Please Do:

- ❖ Ask for help when you need it
- ❖ Be respectful of others' rights
- ❖ Enjoy your time here

Please Do Not:

- ❖ Smoke on library property
- ❖ Leave children 6 years or younger unattended
- ❖ Run
- ❖ Consume food or drink within the main library
- ❖ Skateboard on library property (City Ordinance)
- ❖ Talk or play audio equipment at a volume which disturbs others
- ❖ Be disruptive, disorderly, harass patrons or staff, or otherwise endanger the health or safety of others
- ❖ Conduct commercial or illegal activities
- ❖ Conduct surveys
- ❖ Panhandle or solicit
- ❖ Destroy, deface, or abuse library property

In addition to the above, violation of any Federal or State statute or local ordinance will be regarded as a violation of library rules. The Lincoln County Library District reserves the right to cause to be ejected or refuse further admission to those who violate library rules, create disorder, or engage in illegal activity.
